Who we are

Natural Resources Wales is a new organisation. It was set up in April 2013 to look after the **environment** and **natural resources** in Wales.



The **environment** is where we live. It includes the land, the sea, the air, and everything that lives in and on it. For example: plants, animals and fish.



Natural resources are things in the environment we can use. For example: water to drink, food to eat, air to breathe, wind and water to make energy.



If we take care of the environment, we will be able to use its natural resources for many years to come.

We have a big job to do. This is our 3 year plan. It sets out what we want to do to look after the environment and protect our natural resources for the future.

- How will the environment change?



How much energy and food will we need?




To understand these changes, we need good information and to learn more.

To do this we will:

- Work closely with other organisations.
- Look at the big picture. For example: If we make changes to the environment we will look at how the changes will affect plants, animals and birds, as well as people and businesses.
- Find out about the needs of businesses in Wales. For example: how much water and energy they will need.

We want to keep plants, animals and fish healthy.

To do this we will:

Think about the future when we make decisions today.



Use our natural resources carefully, so they can be used for many years to come.

Keep an eye on plants and animals that carry diseases.



 Find ways to protect the environment from changes in the weather. For example: severe storms and heavy rain.
