

DESCRIPTION: This route meanders around the only bit of flat ground in the area. An easy gradient with a fine surface makes it suitable for wheelchair access.

Amser: 1.5 awr
Dringo: 463tr/141m

Moderate
Distance: 2.6 miles/4.4km
Time: 1.5 hours
Climb: 463ft/141m

UCHAFBWYNTIAU:
Adlewyrchiad godidog ar wyneb llonydd y llyn, ar fore clir.

HIGHLIGHTS:
The fantastic reflection on the lake on a clear, still morning.

DESCRIPTION: The forest path is rough underfoot in places, with tree roots and slippery stones requiring some care. Starting from Geirionnydd, the path ascends gently up the forest road to a high point and then steeply down into the Crafnant valley.

Golygfa ar draws y llyn tuag at glogwyni mawreddog Cwm Crafnant.

DISGRIFIAD: Mae'r daith hon yn dilyn ffordd lydan drwy'r goedwig a ffordd darnac gul, gydag un darn o lwybr troed mynediad hawdd. Gyda thair gât mochyn a dwy gât.

HIGHLIGHTS:
The view across the lake to the towering crags at the head of the Crafnant Valley.

DESCRIPTION: This route follows a wide forest road and a single track tarmac road, with one section of easy access footpath. There are 3 kissing gates and 2 gates.

Golygfeydd eang ar draws Cwm Crafnant tuag at Foel Siabod a'r Carneddau.

DISGRIFIAD: Mae'r rhan fwyaf o'r daith hon yn dilyn ffordd coedwig llydan a ffordd darnac gul gyda llwybr cul, serth a mwdlyd drwy'r goedwig yn eu cysylltu. Gofal piau hi, gan fod llwybr y goedwig yn arw dan draed mewn rhai llefydd, gyda gwreiddiau coed a cherrig lliθrig.

HIGHLIGHTS:
The panoramic views across the Crafnant valley to Moel Siabod and the Carneddau mountains.

DESCRIPTION: The majority of this route is on wide forest roads and a single track tarmac road, linked by a steep and muddy descent on a narrow forest path. The forest path is rough underfoot in places, with tree roots and slippery stones requiring some care.

Croeso i Llyn Geirionnydd

Croeso i Llyn Geirionnydd, cartref honedig y bardd o'r 6ed ganrif, Taliesin. Mae olion cofeb faen iddo'n sefyll ar y lan ogleddol.

Mae'n anodd dychmygu mai tirwedd ddiwydiannol ddiffaith oedd hon yn y 1870au. Yn wir mae'r maes parcio hwn yn gorwedd ar domen wastraff ger mynedfa hen fwynglawdd plwm. Roedd tramffordd ar hyd lan ddwyreiniol y llyn yn cludo mwyn plwm i raffordd awyr. Roedd hyn yn dwyn y mwyn i lawr i felin a mwynglawdd plwm y Klondyke 200 troedfedd islaw'r llyn. Cawsai'r felin ei phweru gan ddŵr o'r llyn.

Welcome to Llyn Geirionnydd

Welcome to Llyn Geirionnydd (say gay-ree-ON-ith), reputedly the home of the 6th century poet Taliesin. The remains of a stone monument to him stand by the north bank.

It is difficult to imagine that this was a derelict industrial landscape in the 1870s. In fact, this car park lies on a waste tip near an old lead mine entrance. A tramway along the eastern lakeshore delivered lead ore to an aerial ropeway. This took the ore down to the Klondyke lead mill and mine 200 ft below the lake. The mill was powered by water from the lake.

Why not discover this beautiful lake on our waymarked trail. You can also cross Mynydd Deulyn to Llyn Crafnant.
